## The gospel goes high-tech and reaches new heights for Christ

Torizons missionary S\* knows the importance of getting the Gospel into as many hands as possible in North Africa. To accomplish his goal, he's taking the Gospel to new high-tech heights!

The problem S faces is that in North Africa, printed Bibles are often unavailable and difficult to distribute due to the risk of them being discovered. And believers risk being rejected, harrassed, and persecuted by their families and communities.

## So what's the solution?

It's important to note, nearly everyone in this region has a cell phone with a micro SD card slot. (SD Cards are usually used for storing photos, music, files, etc)

S's idea was to put the entire Bible and everything else a believer might want on a SD card for their phone. This way believers will have access to the Word of God, hymns, devotionals, lessons, and more at their fingertips all the time - giving them access they could only dream of before!

To make this happen, S needed 200 micro SD cards (which would last him through the end of the year) and would cost approximately \$850.

God has provided mightily and at the time of printing S has received the \$850 he needed to purchase 200 SD cards! We ask you to pray for the distribution of these cards, that God will use them in a powerful way.

Along with SD cards, S is also developing social media ads to reach others with the Gospel. S is working with a believer living outside of the region who buys weekly Facebook and Google ads. The ad simply asks local Christians to call.

This believer reported to S that from this one simple ad he receives:

- 650 calls each week
- 400+ SMS messages
- 300+ Facebook messages
- 40+ new open seekers found
- five to seven new believers located
- face-to-face meetings with 20-30 seeking Muslims, atheists, or agnostics.

He receives these responses **Every. Single. Week.** If S can get the funds to take out another weekly ad (around \$300), these responses will be even greater!

We applaud S's desire to reach his mission field for Christ in any way possible. What an amazing example of faithfulness, ingenuity and a heart to serve and reach the world for Christ.
