ENGAGING ISLAM INSTITUTE 2018

This year's first of two Engaging Islam Institutes was held at Horizons' Lebanon headquarters from June 4-15. Attendees and teachers alike were blessed with 10 days of instruction, fellowship, and hands-on evangelism. This training equipped over 135 attendees from Lebanon, Syria, Jordan, Iraq, New Zealand, China, Russia, and the U.S.

In addition to in-depth classroom instruction, participants took part in several days of outreach, both on the streets and by visiting Syrian refugee camps. Stopping at tents and ministering to refugees, as well as taking part in Horizons-organized worship events and children's events, participants were coached as they experienced first-hand what it means to share the gospel with those in need. In all, participants reached hundreds of Muslims in 3 different areas of Lebanon with the gospel!

THE LORD'S ABUNDANCE IN AFRICA



André Houssney is back from his fruitful three-week trip to Rwanda and Burundi. On this visit, he investigated potential partnerships for Zambia-based Sambah Naturals with local ministries and Whole Foods. Sambah, an economic ministry, partners with 10,000 farmers—but these partnerships could increase that number to nearly 60,000!

On this trip, Andre built low-cost distillation equipment for a Burundian village using repurposed parts, bringing technology that typically costs tens of thousands of dollars to these villagers for less than \$1,000. Additionally, he worked with other ministries and companies such as Dan Brose and Pacha in order to build potential partnerships.

"It's unfair to make the world's poorest people dependent on Western charity," André says. "Sambah is focused on enabling them to generate real income through a reproducible business model." Sambah's profits not only support African families, but fund indigenous church missions through WOTA Ministries and "It's unfair to make the world's poorest people dependent on Western charity"

André proposed Sambah's method and products to Whole Foods executives, **whose partnership could land Sambah essential oils in Whole Foods stores nationwide** and employ tens of thousands more farmers. The Middle East Center for World Missions is an ambitious new project that stands to change the face of Christianity in the Middle East. Through Horizons' ground-level involvement in over 8 countries in the MENA region, as well as numerous partnerships with national churches and ministries, God has revealed an opportunity to catalyze regional church unity on a scale never before envisioned, a vision of synergetic collaboration built on our decades of work to equip the Church for the Great Commission.

WELCOME TO THE

The MEC will serve as a pivotal piece of strategic infrastructure in the region, to link and empower a network of local ministries and churches. The evangelical church in the MENA region is still a young and growing patchwork of entities, in need of a shared platform for communication, strategy, training, education, and sending capacity.

As a physical hub and gathering place for training and missions in the Middle East, the MEC will be an entry point for believers from outside the region who want to get involved, and also will mobilize and equip indigenous missionaries to serve in their region and abroad.

Why Beirut?

Beirut, Lebanon, provides opportunities that no other city in the Middle East can offer:

- 1. Freedom of religion
- 2. Large Christian populations
- 3. The highest concentration of evangelical churches in the **MENA** region
- 4. Central location a strategic key to the region.

The MEC is projected to have the capacity to house and equip 220 long-term students annually, plus thousands of short-term students and instructors. Our aim is to fund and purchase land by 2023, be partially operational by 2025, and fully operational by 2030. In this ambitious undertaking, we firmly believe that the Lord will be faithful to provide for the vision he has given us!

Horizons establishes 4 more ministry centers, housing for 70+ guests, a school, a campground, and a media studio in Lebanon, plus 8 more ministry centers in

nearby countries.

Public fundraising begins, with a goal of \$7 million USD over a 3-year campaign, to acquire a property in Northeast Beirut.

MEC's academies continue to develop building student bodies, partnering with churches and organizations to provide training, and utilizing Horizons facilities until MEC's main facility is built.

MEC's partially completed facility opens its doors, allowing its growing academies begin to move into the spaces designed for them, having outgrown their temporary locations.

The MEC isn't a building. It's a movement, and it has already started! With so many areas of Kingdom building, teams from around the world are coming to bring their own expertise and passion to the field!

EVANGELISM AND DISCIPLESHIP

In June 2018, Asbury United Methodist Church in Tulsa, OK, sent a team to provide administrative and logistical support for the Engaging Islam Institute in Beirut. This enabled Horizons' Lebanese staff to focus on curriculum, participant care, and training. Over 105 mostly indigenous ministers of the gospel were trained through this event, and hundreds of Muslims heard the gospel through outreaches during the event. The Evangelism and Discipleship Academy's goal is to equip thousands more for fruitful ministry among Muslims around the world.

WORSHIP ARTS SEMINAR

Crossroads Church in Colorado sent a vision team to Beirut in Jan 2017 to explore how to get involved, and they brought instruments to donate to the Horizons studio! In early 2019, Pastor Brad Richardson will lead a team of "musicianaries" to conduct Worship Music seminars and coaching. Multiple Lebanese partner churches will send participants, to develop and improve their worship teams.

LANGUAGE ACQUISITION ACADEMY -SMALL BEGINNINGS THROUGH TUTORING

Horizons Lebanon has been tutoring visitors, interns, and foreign staff, helping them learn Arabic in order to serve in Lebanon. We plan to develop these efforts into a language academy for not only Arabic, but also to teach language acquisition techniques, preparing indigenous missionaries to learn languages wherever they are sent.

PRAYER FOR ALL NATIONS CENTER






GIVE TODAY

These efforts are part of a plan to increase the administrative capacity of local churches, helping them in areas such as project planning, fundraising, accounting, designated funds management, church databases, and more.
