AHLAM'S TESTIMONY

In April 2017, I experienced a terrible tragedy—**15 members of my family died in one day**, during the Syrian War. When I heard the news, it turned my life upside down, filling me with despair and gloom. I was suddenly unable to enjoy my life and felt disconnected from my husband and children.

The tragedy caused me to lose faith in the god of Islam, and I became an atheist. I kept asking: "God, even though I'm righteous, I read the Qur'an, I fast and pray, and do good deeds—**why would you take my family?** And especially my beloved sister?!" I completely isolated myself from people and placed a great deal of blame on God.

I had never felt joy or peace within Islam. No matter what I did, I always felt that God was disapproving of me. All my life, I wondered what would happen to me after I died, and no one was able to answer my question.

During this difficult time, a faithful sister from Horizons, Sahar, heard my story and visited me. Despite my initial reluctance to talk to her, **she visited and prayed for me regularly.** Eventually, I began to trust her—her words were a comfort to me.

Sahar took me to meetings at a Horizons Center, where I learned about Jesus. My understanding of salvation was transformed when I realized that **we are saved by grace**, **not by works**, and that he died for us—to save us from our sins. I took my first step into faith in Jesus.

I am now a servant of Christ! I have been trained in evangelism and discipleship, and have learned the Christian life, taken leadership training, and attended numerous conferences. These all have greatly contributed to my spiritual growth and my relationship with the Lord. I **now teach and mentor 50-60 women.** And although I lost my sister, God has blessed me with a spiritual family. I serve alongside 12 beloved sisters in Christ!

In my darkest times, the Lord gave me worth and resurrected my soul to a new life in Christ. I hope that everyone, especially Muslims, will come to know the Lord as I do. Since becoming a Christian, I have found great joy and hope, and a smile that never fades!



THE CHURCH PERSEVERES AMIDST TRIALS

And I tell you, you are Peter, and on this rock I will build my church, and the gates of hell shall not prevail against it. I will give you the keys of the kingdom of heaven, and whatever you bind on earth shall be bound in heaven, and whatever you loose on earth shall be loosed in heaven.

After a season of exponential growth, the church in Algeria is enduring a troubling rise in persecution. **Believers are increasingly experiencing restrictions** and pressure from state officials designed to cause them to renounce their faith, and stifle the influence of Christianity.



The Chinese Communist Party (CCP) is tightening its grip over religion by persecuting Christians and rewriting parts of the Bible to force the church to be subservient to the state. Certain portions of the 'official' Bible have been rewritten such as changing the story in John 8, which now shows Jesus stoning an adulterous woman to death, and modifying the first commandment in Exodus 20 to read "Resolutely guard against the infiltration of Western ideology." 🜙 AFGHANISTAN

Since the U.S. withdrawal from Afghanistan in 2021, Christians have faced regular home raids, restrictions on work and education, and threats of violence against their families. Due to the Taliban's restrictions on contact with the West, humanitarian relief efforts have ground to a halt.

Christians are still highly at risk of being reported to, and tortured by, the Taliban. Many have fled, but despite the dangers, **there are reports of Afghan Muslims secretly converting to Christianity** and even meeting together.

The Iranian government is cracking down on Christians during ongoing civil unrest, as believers are considered enemies of the state. Protests have erupted over stricter hijab laws, leading to violent repression by the government. Despite facing persecution and imprisonment, **Iranian Christians continue to spread the gospel**. In fact, Iran is believed to have the world's fastest-growing church due to a significant increase in conversions in recent years.

Anyone who chooses to follow God can face persecution (2 Tim 3:12). Yet we can take comfort in the Lord's promise that he will 'never leave us or forsake us' (Heb 13:5). Let us pray for believers who are facing persecution, that they would find strength and comfort in God during their trials.



Every week, lives are transformed during house visits throughout Lebanon. Many are coming to know Christ and being discipled within their homes.

Jesus sent out 12 disciples to conduct ministry visits, spreading hope and healing to people as they traveled throughout the region, as recorded in Matthew 10. 2,000 years later, thanks to your prayers and partnership in the gospel, Horizons is following in the disciples' footsteps by bringing the light of Christ into homes.

Horizons staff members use their relational skills to form deeper connections with people they meet, whether on the street or at a ministry event. **Middle Eastern hospitality makes it easy for staff to get invited into homes**, and they are good at steering the conversation toward Jesus while sipping tiny cups of strong coffee. Throughout Lebanon, Horizons staff make at least 70 of these house visits each week.

Opportunities to meet in homes build a level of mutual trust and openness that is not easily replicated within a church service. Many Muslims, fearful of visiting a church, can ask questions in a safe environment while building relationships with believers!

House visits are wonderful opportunities for our teams to actively live out their faith, reading the Word, discussing questions about scripture, and—most importantly— praying together. As Susanne Johnson, a Horizons board member, shared after a recent house visit, "Once people get in the habit of doing things that disciples do, it is often just a matter of time before the truth takes root in their hearts and they become true followers of Christ."



People are being transformed through experiencing Christ in this way. **And it is not just those whom we visit who are being transformed.** Staff members, volunteers, and vision trip guests are also being inspired as they see God answer prayers and transform lives:



A former Muslim shared how she had thought we were slaves to God, but now that she knows that God is a Father, she is a daughter of God!

I felt like I was walking through the book of Acts after listening to the testimonies of two ladies and how they were drawn to Christ. They had heard the gospel preached and listened to stories of Jesus. They shared how, despite being strict followers of Islam, they and their husbands **could not resist the grace of God shown to them** through Christ's sacrifice on the cross. Jesus revealed Himself in their dreams!
