HAMEED: A REFUGEE'S TESTIMONY

I lived for 25 years as a Kurdish Yazidi in Syria—until the civil war. My family's hometown of Afrin was attacked and occupied by ISIS, so we fled to Lebanon.

I was depressed and found it hard to live as a refugee, but thankfully, God sent Kurdish Christians to find me and minister to me. They took me to a Kurdish church service, where I enjoyed worshipping and learning about Jesus.

For months I was full of doubt, but eventually I began praying to God, testing him to see if he was real. Then He spoke to me, saying, "I see you and live inside you." He told me, "I am Your God; do not fear. I chose you, and I want you to sing for Me." At that moment, my new life began, full of hope and light. Praise God!

I found my calling as an evangelist, and my testimony played a part in bringing over 50 members of my family to Christ.

Every day we serve the Kingdom to see more people saved—and I am thankful that I have spent the last 5 years serving with Horizons. For me, Horizons has been an open door to all the ministries I could possibly carry out.

Whenever I'd want to share Jesus with someone, I could always bring them to Horizons, where there are services in any language they'd need (whether Arabic, Kurdish, or Armenian), free gospel materials, and discipleship classes. It's an amazing community—a perfect place to bring new seekers from any background.

I have been set free in the Lord, and I pray that we will all work together in the Great Commission until all are saved!







MINISTRY CENTERS BRINGING CHRIST TO COMMUNITIES

Since 2012, Horizons has implemented a successful evangelism and discipleship center model in Beirut, which has resulted in thousands of Muslims coming to faith in Christ, engaging in long-term discipleship relationships, reaching other Muslims for Christ, and building effective missional partnerships with over 65 local churches. Horizons has expanded and replicated this model in three locations in Lebanon, including Tripoli, the Beqaa Valley, and South Lebanon. Outside of Lebanon, we partner with local churches and ministries to engage in evangelism and discipleship among Muslims in countries such as Syria, Jordan, Egypt, Tunisia, Morocco, Algeria, and Turkey.



STRATEGY: STAGES IN ESTABLISHING A MINISTRY CENTER

STAGE 1: SOWING SEEDS FROM AFAR

Horizons identifies a location in a strategic area for reaching Muslims. Teams of staff members, interns, and volunteers begin taking regular short-term trips to the area to build relationships with Muslims and select a space to rent or purchase for the ministry center. Horizons collaborates with local churches and ministries in the area to carry out evangelism and follow up with seekers.

STAGE 2: BUILDING A LOCAL TEAM

Local residents come to Christ and the center launches initiatives to disciple them thoroughly. Horizons invites volunteers from local churches to serve in the center, and trains them in Horizons' ministry approach and values. Ministry activities are still mostly dependent on short-term trips from other centers, but local interns and volunteers begin to catch the vision and are empowered to serve.

STAGE 3: LOCALLY-RUN CENTER

The ministry center is now wellestablished, serving as a hub for evangelism and discipleship programs. Full-time local staff organize and run the evangelistic and discipleship programs, solidify the network of local partner churches, and coordinate groups of staff, interns, and volunteers serving on short-term trips. As the center matures, its staff members begin helping to plant new ministry centers in surrounding areas.

CUBS TO LIONS

In his life's work among Muslims, Georges Houssney found that large numbers of Christians from Muslim backgrounds (CMBs) left the body of Christ due to weak spiritual foundations, persecution, loss of family and friends, and difficulty assimilating into Christian churches and communities. As a result, the Lord directed Georges to develop the Cubs to Lions curriculum. For over two decades. Cubs to Lions has strengthened CMBs through spiritual mentorship, relationship with mature Christians, and solid biblical foundation.

Cubs to Lions attendees have grown into disciplers, leaders, and teachers serving worldwide, thanks to courses offered in Beirut, Hong Kong, Morocco, Tunisia, Kosovo, Australia, France, Kenya, South Africa, Tatarstan, and Canada. In light of the program's popularity and effectiveness, Horizons is expanding CTL even farther to reach the nations!

- **CTL Family Edition curriculum** is nearly complete, to help CMB families adapt to their new lives as a Christ-centered unit. This new course will inform attendees' perspectives on how to approach romantic relationships and raise children with God's agape love.
- In July 2019, Horizons completed a Farsi curriculum translation and hosted the first CTL specifically for Iranian converts. We plan to offer more Farsi translation for CTL moving forward, as well as a Farsi video project for use in Iranian churches, satellite TV stations, and internet sites.
- Georges and Horizons' CTL staff are currently developing more CTLcertified instructors in Beirut and beyond. Additionally, in 2020 we plan to launch online resources to spread the gospel more effectively.

Engaging Islam Institute (EII) is another training format designed by Georges Houssney. This twoweek modular course equips churches for outreach and ministry to Muslims through teaching from experienced evangelists, disciplers, and Muslimbackground leaders.

Engaging Islam Institute participants receive intensive on-site training that combines effective teaching modules with role-playing, class discussion, and even guided street evangelism.

In 2019, Horizons conducted Ell events in Beirut, Lebanon and Dearborn, Michigan. In 2020, Horizons is launching the year-round Engaging Islam Academy at the Middle East Center (MEC) in Beirut

PERSECUTED CHRISTIANS AID FOR THOSE IN NEED


Most Muslims who openly proclaim their faith in Christ experience forms of persecution from family, community, religious leaders, and government. Some are able to find a way to live out their faith in their own location, among their own people. However, others must seek refuge in nearby countries, where they live isolated without support systems, resources, or gainful employment.

Horizons takes an active role in several stages of assisting and ministering to persecuted Christians—both helping them to remain where they are when possible, and intervening to shelter and assist them when they are forced to relocate. Over the last 30 years, Horizons has connected with and helped over 250 persecuted Christians from the most restrictive Islamic countries in the world.

Many Christians from Muslim backgrounds face constant challenges in adapting to their new lives. In each believer's unique circumstances, Horizons provides aid tailored to their needs:

- Spiritual mentorship and relational support
- Job acquisition and employment assistance
- Food disbursement. medical care. and educational resources
- Connection to local Christians and churches
- Discipleship and ministry training (Cubs to Lions, Gulf Arab Retreat, and Engaging Islam)
- Relocation, shelter, and legal asylum assistance

Persecuted believers have been introduced to Horizons through many of our regional and local partners. They know us because of our ministry infrastructure in Lebanon, and our deep integration into Christian networks throughout the Middle East. While some organizations provide only financial aid to persecuted Christians, we believe it is essential to combine practical aid with spiritual care. That holistic approach is the key to moving beyond basic needs, into truly empowering these persecuted Christians and raising them up as effective leaders of the next generation.



HORIZONS **INTERNATIONAL ASIA:** SPREADING THE GOSPEL

Since 2015, Horizons International Asia has ministered to seekers and believers in Hong Kong, Malaysia, Taiwan, and two nearby countries in Central Asia. To reach the surrounding community, HI Asia's three staff members and over 30 volunteers conduct street outreach and evangelism, discipleship meetings, and Horizons training events.



Edward and Sandy, HI Asia's lead staff members, take frequent mission trips to a closed Muslim-majority country, where they are starting an import/export business to raise capital for future mission trips and local discipleship. In Hong Kong and Taiwan, HI Asia staff members are growing our capacity to host training and discipleship events.

HI Asia has scheduled three Engaging Islam Institute courses for the first half of 2020, and has sent short-term missions teams and interns to Lebanon to serve in Horizons ministry centers. Amidst political unrest and uncertainty, we pray that more and more Asian seekers will seek refuge in the house of Christ.



SOWING SEEDS THROUGHOUT AFRICA



Horizons' partner, for-profit Sambah Naturals, generates revenue from Zambianmade products to support WOTA Ministries, an organization committed to community ministry and missions. Together, they strengthen the Zambian Church's ability to undertake local and international missions. In early 2020, WOTA will partner with many churches to send Zambia's first three missionaries outside of Africa, to serve with Horizons' teams in Lebanon! The result of many years of spiritual and financial growth, these missionaries will hopefully be the first of many to develop the Zambian church's connection to the worldwide body of Christ.







For several years, Horizons teams have been making mission and discipleship trips to minister to groups of CMBs in two closed countries in Northern Africa. One group has actually formed into a church, and in 2019 Horizons helped them to appoint their first pastor! Also, this church has connected us to similar groups forming throughout the country. Through house visits, discipleship meetings and seminars, and time spent teaching the Word, Horizons' MENA staff are helping raise up mature believers who catalyze organic church growth in countries under Islamic control.

Allain and Nicole Ravelo-Hoerson use lifestyle evangelism to minister to Muslims directly, and they equip Christians to minister to Muslims. In 2019 they led outreach teams, helped 5 churches adopt missional approaches toward Muslims, taught an annual course on Muslim evangelism at Bible Institute of South Africa, and more. Moving forward, they are focusing on teaching courses in apologetics and practical approaches to help raise up a new generation of younger believers equipped to engage with and disciple Muslims.





Horizons has partnered with two local churches to offer an "Approaches to the Gospel" course. As its popularity has grown, God is opening doors for us to meet and partner with several churches from various denominational backgrounds. We pray that this course, and others like it, will increase cooperation and integration between Egyptian churches.



International Crossroads reaches the nations where we are by connecting college campuses with nearby churches and ministries. Recruiting and organizing volunteers, IC helps catalyze campus ministry programs to reach international students with the gospel.

This student-centered initiative fulfills a unique role on 10 university campuses in 7 states. Currently, IC's fourteen full-time staff members help 168 local church members to volunteer as friendship partners, English instructors, Bible teachers, event coordinators, and evangelists.

IC staff members make contact with international students through campus events and church-sponsored friendship dinners. They then engage students more personally in Bible study groups or one-toone discipleship, and connect them to members of local churches. In 2019, IC helped activate 31 churches to serve 1500 students from Hindu, Buddhist, Muslim, atheist, and agnostic backgrounds!

Jim Rairick, our National Director of International Student Ministry, is focusing on two strategic initiatives over the next 3 years:



1. Onboard more volunteers and staff members in existing locations, to create more robust outreach initiatives and effective support networks for internationals.

2. Launch between 3-5 new International Crossroads sites by 2023. Over a million international students from across the world gather in our communities, and they are ready to hear the gospel. Pray that many American Christians seize this amazing opportunity to reach the nations without even leaving their hometown!


